

BY-LAWS - TOWN AND COUNTRY NATURISTS

PURPOSE:- The purpose of these By-Laws is to provide guidelines for the day-to-day operation of the Club and not to replace nor negate the Club Constitution. These By-Laws may be changed as is deemed necessary at a meeting of the Management Committee. The Management Committee may approve or decline such changes via any manner permitted in the constitution.

GUIDELINES ON CONDUCT:- All members and guests will conduct themselves in a decorous manner at all functions. Event organisers will have the power to

{i} request a member or guest leave the venue or event for a period of time or

{ii} decline permission to enter the venue or event without explanation.

A refund of any venue and/or lifestyle fee can be made to retain good faith with that person and an opportunity to repair the issue which caused the exclusion. Behaviour unbecoming to the ladies and gentlemen of the Club will be reviewed by the Management Committee. Action taken will depend on the gravity of the offense.

Serious offenses such as inebriation, foul language, verbal abuse, rumour spreading and physical violence are offenses that could call for expulsion from the Club. Lesser offenses could receive reprimands. All such cases shall be reviewed by the Management Committee. Those expelled will receive no pro-rata refunds of their membership fees. Any event booking fees, prepaid prior to the expulsion or exclusion period, would be refunded in full.

VENUE BOOKINGS:- All arrangements with any venue will be made by the Events Coordinator of CLUB ZERO or those so delegated by the officers of the Management Committee to represent them. No member or other person shall have the right or authority to represent themselves as having such authority to act on behalf of the Club, to complain, negotiate or seek changes that concern the Club and their dealings with, and relationship with, any Venue.

MEMBERSHIP - PRO RATA:- The management committee may reduce the annual fee per Ordinary Member or Pending Member adjusted for the time left in the Financial Year of the Club.

DRESS CODE:- "Minimal Dress or Less" is defined as a Modesty Bib Apron or Sarong for both male and female. The club permits the wearing of underwear for sanitary purposes when required by members. Weather and common sense will also dictate the dress code and will be determined by the Event Supervisors at that time. When an event is classified as 'nude' then no apparel is to be worn without the express permission of an Event Supervisor.

CLUB TRADITION:- The Club, formed in 1983, has been originally, and traditionally, for heterosexual adult couples {with or without children}. The clothing of youngsters will always be at the discretion of their parents – even at totally nude

family events – and that discretion supersedes any directive from an Event Supervisor.

NON COMPETITION POLICY:- The Club does not seek to duplicate, or compete with, the style of other adult clubs catering for those with sexual intent or same sex relationships. The Club should maintain good faith with other existing “Nude Lifestyle” clubs in the graphical area by not duplicating similar events within a 15 kilometre radius of an existing activity.

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
