Connections:- Ensure all involved in any car pooling exercise have exchanged contact details. i.e. Mobile Phone numbers.

Departure Times:- The departure time is exactly that. Be there early rather than looking at a car driving off in the distance. This works for both the outgoing and return journey.

Reimbursements:- Usually a gratuity or something based on a per kilometre distance. Here are some examples.:-

Assembly at Logan Hyperdome and travel to Tyagarah Beach and return is 260km. So at 10¢ a kilometre reimbursement a round figure of \$20 would be appropriate if in a group - and more if you are a sole passenger.

Smaller trips can be \$5 for the convenience to \$10 if a sole passenger. The best way is simply to place the reimbursement in an envelope with your name on it and toss it in

the glove-box or centre console of the car. Or maybe pay for some fuel for the car during the trip.

You all have a tongue in your head – so talk it out with the person giving you a lift. And best of all – be generous rather than stingy. Especially if you want to be considered as a future guest in that vehicle.
