**Houl rules the roost
at the U Furu nudist campsite**



Nestled deep within a sunny, vibrant green valley in southern Corsica, U Furu offers a delightfully laid-back European naturist escape - provided you understand who is **actually** running the show. That honour goes squarely to Houl, the resident cat, who

confidently rules the roost over this tranquil patch of paradise.



Located just a short 15-minute, €30 taxi ride from Porto-Vecchio, U Furu is currently drawing a diverse crowd from across Europe, with plenty of French folk in residence. The grounds are currently dotted with a lively community of rental vans and, while the site oddly features a washing machine for some unknown purpose (surely a bit redundant when wardrobe requirements are this minimal?), the vibe is thoroughly relaxed.



The Bare Essentials

True to the classic European naturist ethos, the communal showers are fully open, mixed, and proudly on display to the world. It's wonderfully liberating and sets a great tone for the site.



The centrepiece of social life here is the lovely, big, refreshing swimming pool, which slopes down to a deep two metres at one

end. A common pastime in the afternoon is simply sitting around the pool deck, chatting in a delightful melody of foreign languages, and watching fellow holidaymakers do laps.



Better yet, the tap water is completely potable, keeping everyone safely hydrated under the gorgeous 27°C, sunny skies that have held out all week.

If you fancy a bit of adventure, there is a fantastic 30-minute hike that takes you straight to the top of a stunning local waterfall. For anyone used to the rugged Australian bush, the best part of this trek is that there is absolutely nothing trying to kill you on the way!

Dining & The "Dressing" Dilemma

The culinary side of U Furu is expertly managed by Alex, the talented female chef. Bar and restaurant life here is a major highlight. Chef Alex can rustle you up a truly lovely meal, with standout dishes like *pluma*, a succulent local pork served in a rich, flavourful chorizo sauce.



The site does hold a rather specific quirk when it comes to timing though. While you can grab your fresh morning croissants and bagels early, the bar itself doesn't actually open until 10:00 am. This means your morning pastry is enjoyed as a solo act unless you wait it out for that mid-morning

cappuccino. Once open, however, the bar serves all day, with lunch and dinner seamlessly covered.

The club also enforces a distinct shift in clothing policy come evening. The preference is for everyone to remain beautifully nude throughout the day, but there is a rule to dress for dinner around 8:00 pm, coinciding with the closing of the pool. If you prefer to stay in the buff, the trick is simple: eat your dinner before 8:00 pm, and you can happily remain nude.



The Verdict

Pros

- * Superb Meals: Chef Alex consistently delivers fantastic lunches and dinners.
- * Perfect Refreshments: There is nothing quite like a cold beer in perfect 27°C sunny weather.

- * Morning Treats: Fresh croissants and bagels available to kickstart the day.

Cons

- * The Caffeine Wait: Not being able to pair a cappuccino with your breakfast croissant until the bar opens at 10:00 am is a test of patience.
- * Evening Dress Code: Having to dress for dinner feels a bit counterintuitive; a premier site like this should ideally be nude 24/7!
